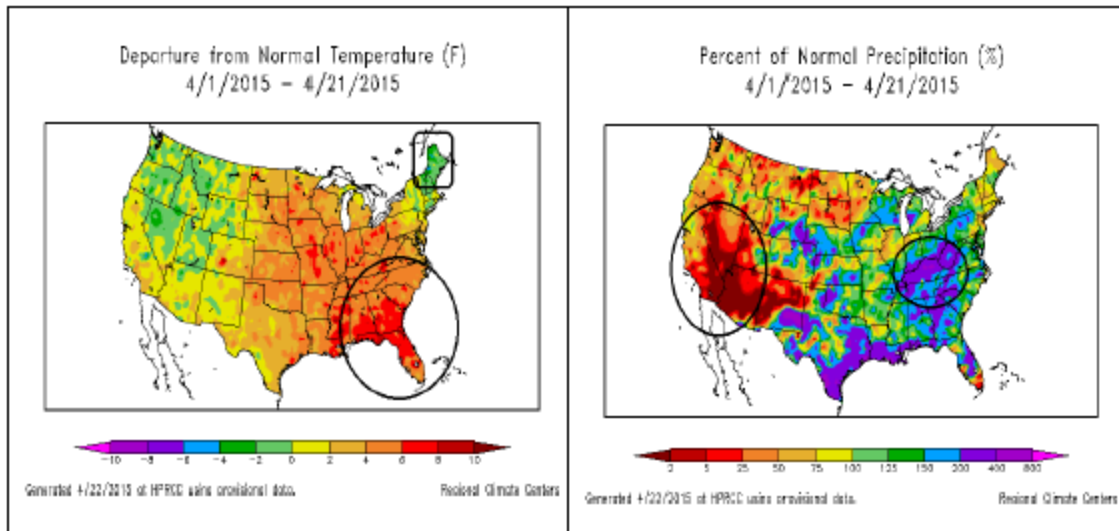

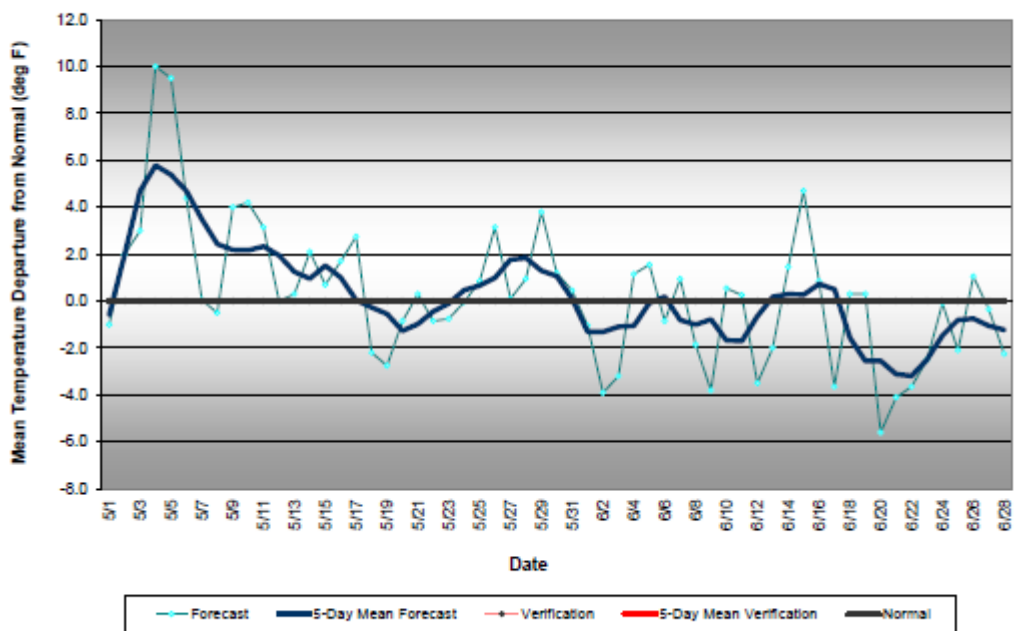

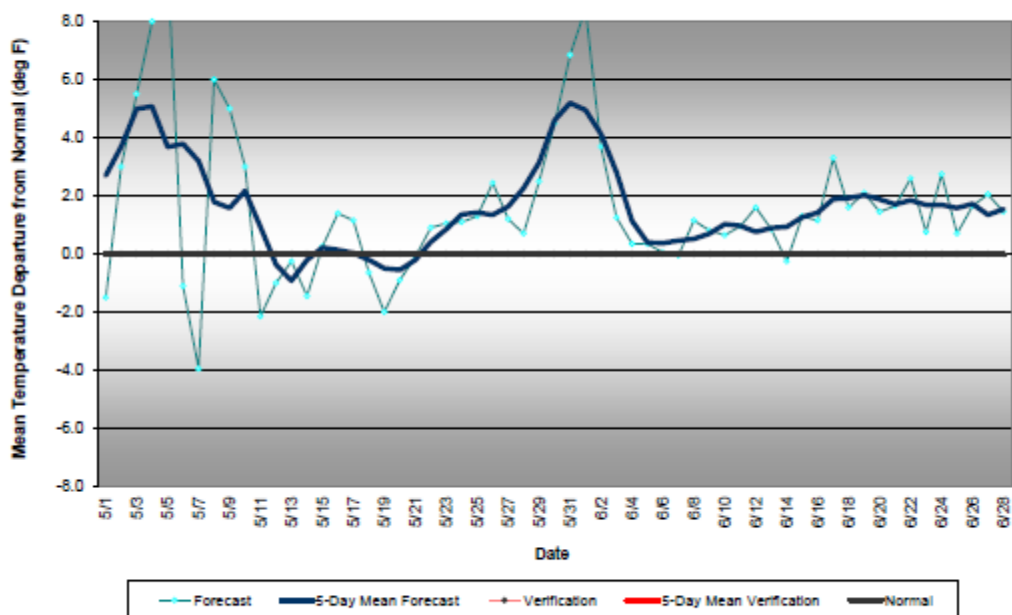
The warmth in the Southeast, cool conditions in Maine along with wet weather in the Ohio Valley and the dry conditions in the Southwest are used as the analog predictors for the next two months. The years listed in yellow are common to two of the anomalous areas with orange indicating three regions in common. The orange years are given more emphasis in the composite analogs (counted twice as much as other years).
