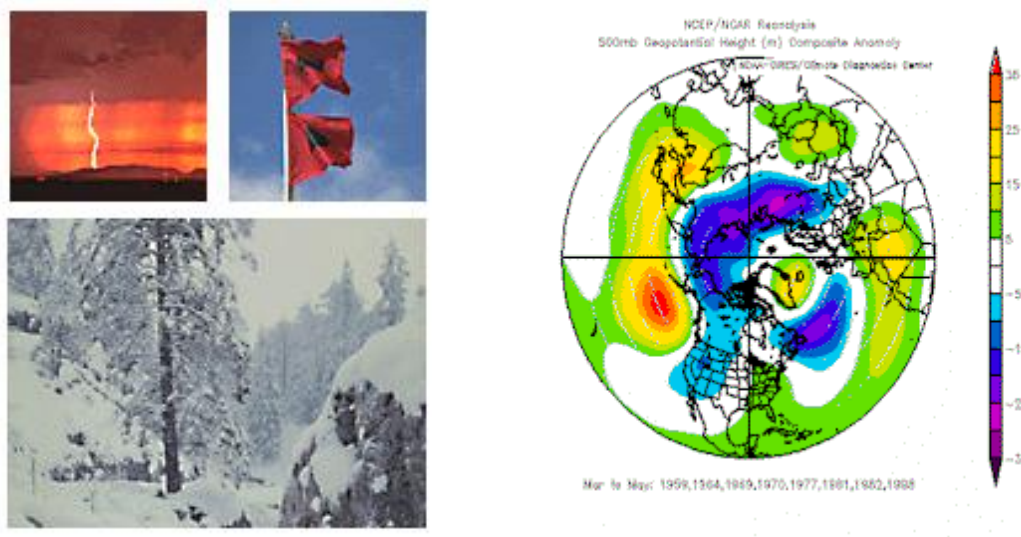

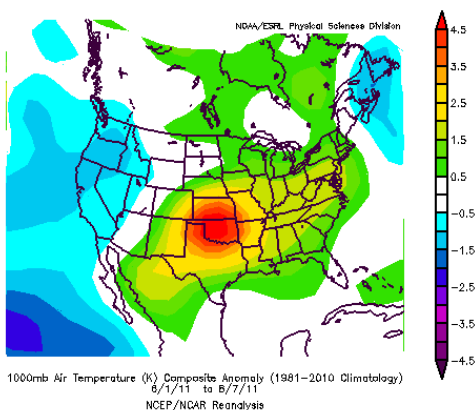

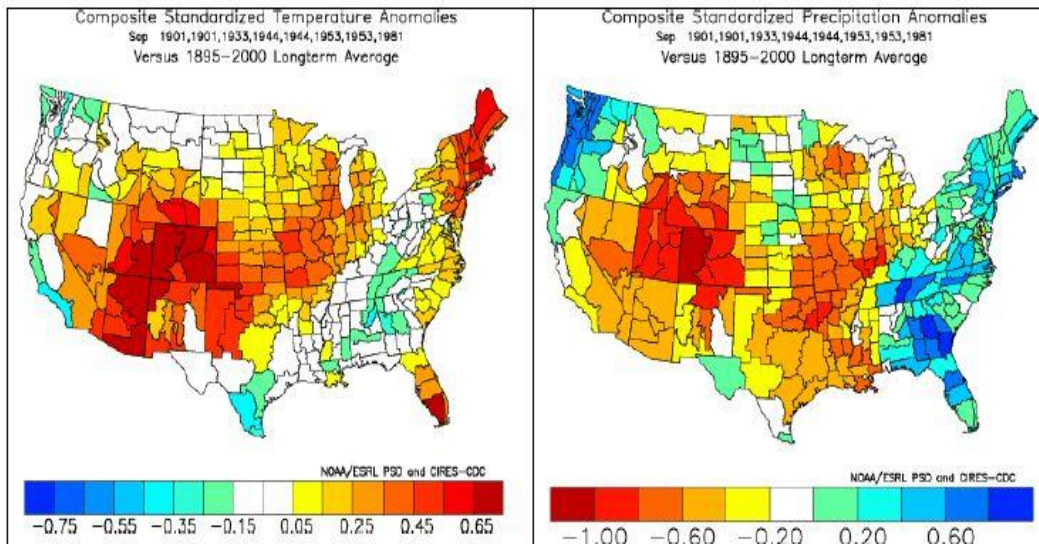
FEATURED CLIMATE HIGHLIGHT

This month's climate highlight provides a glimpse of the fall conditions based on the extreme warmth of the summer temperature anomalies across central and eastern portions of the country.

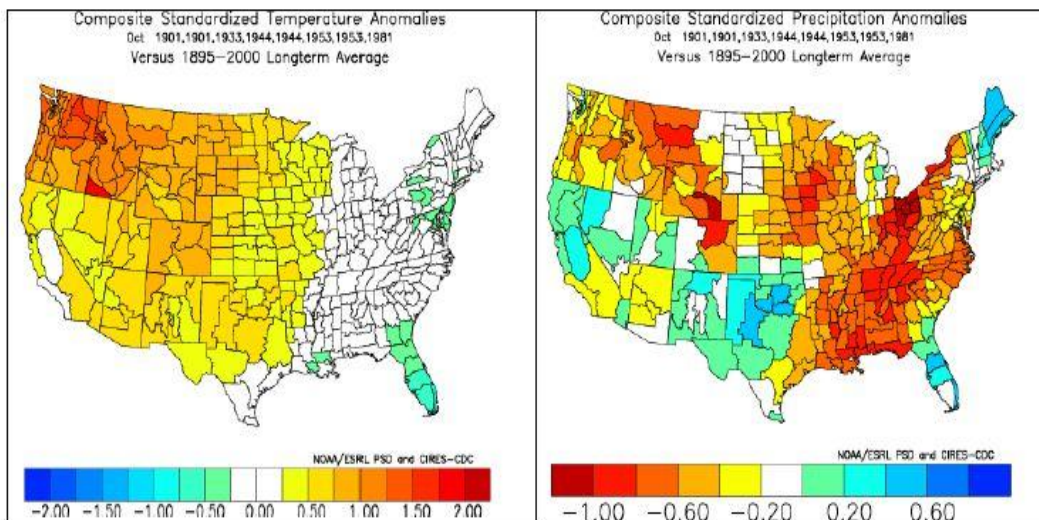
The summer of 2011 has brought much warmer than normal temperatures across most of the middle and eastern portions of the country, particularly the south-central US. West of the Rockies, temperatures were cooler than average.

The Octobers that follow show the following anomalies across the nation:



These composites show near seasonal temperatures for the state throughout September and October, with September being slightly wetter than normal and October drier than normal.
