

September 2014

A see-saw temperature pattern during September ended with monthly averages just a bit above the 30 year mean. However, rainfall, which had been abundant during the warm season, finally tapered off to well below normal with the longest dry spells of 2014 occurring during the ninth month. State College notched more than 13 consecutive days without measurable rain near the end of the month. It was the driest September on record in Wilkes Barre and the third driest on record in Altoona. As a result, severe storms were few with a total of 30 wind damage reports.
